



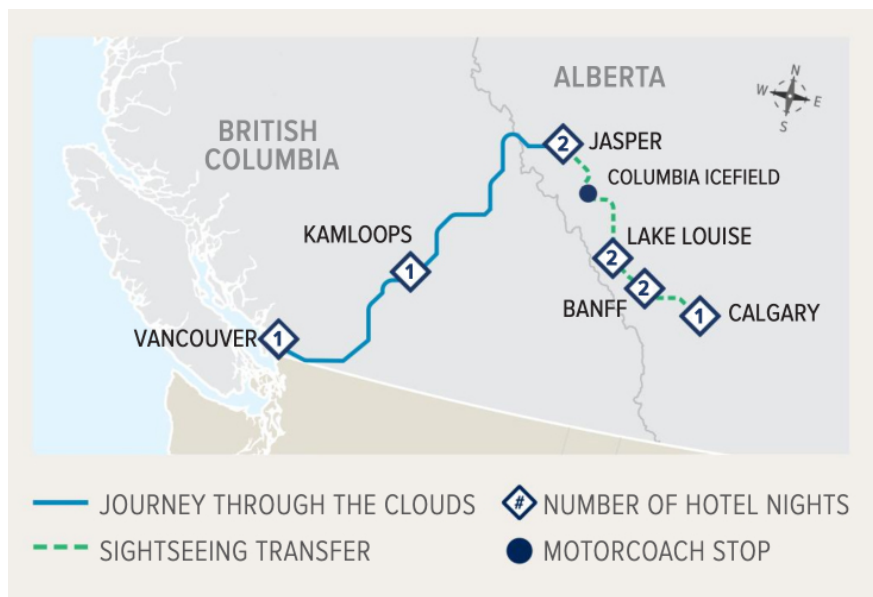

Easy & Iconic Things to Do

- **Bow Falls Walk** – A short, flat stroll from downtown Banff to see the thundering falls.
- **Banff Upper Hot Springs** – Soak in steamy mineral pools with mountain views (great post-hike treat).

Great Hikes (all within ~20 minutes of town)

- **Tunnel Mountain** (easy, 1.5–2 hrs round trip) – Quick climb with views of the town, Bow River, and surrounding peaks.
- **Johnston Canyon** (easy–moderate, 2–4 hrs depending on how far you go) – Catwalks through a narrow canyon, waterfalls, and the option to continue to the Ink Pots.
- **Lake Agnes Tea House Hike** (moderate, ~2–3 hrs up) – Starts at Lake Louise, climbs to a little log cabin tea house on a mountain lake.
- **Plain of Six Glaciers** (longer, ~4–5 hrs) – If your group's up for it, this extends beyond Lake Louise for big glacier views (and another tea house stop).

Active Options

- **Bike the Legacy Trail** – Flat paved trail between Banff & Canmore.
- **Canoe on the Bow River or Vermilion Lakes** – Rentals right in town.
- **Horseback Ride** – Local outfitters lead rides from 1 hr to half-day, complete with cowboy guides.

Explore in Town

- **Banff Avenue** – Shops, galleries, and cafés.
- **Whyte Museum** – Indigenous and settler history of the Rockies.
- **Cascade Gardens** – Pretty spot near the Parks Canada building for a relaxed wander.

- **Lake Louise Lakeshore Walk** – Gentle 2 km walk along the turquoise lake with incredible views of Victoria Glacier. Perfect for photos!
- **Moraine Lake & Valley of the Ten Peaks** – About 20 minutes away. Short strolls to viewpoints or just soak in the scenery.
- **Lake Louise Village** – Small cluster of shops, cafés, and galleries for a relaxing morning coffee or souvenir hunt.

Hiking Options

- **Lake Agnes Tea House** (moderate, 2–3 hrs round trip) – Popular but worth it. Stop at the historic tea house for treats and tea.
- **Plain of Six Glaciers** (moderate, 4–5 hrs) – Longer hike with glacier views and a second tea house along the trail.
- **Fairview Lookout** (moderate, 2–3 hrs) – Great panoramic views of Lake Louise without committing to the longer hikes.
- **Sentinel Pass** (challenging, 5–6 hrs) – Stunning alpine scenery; start at Moraine Lake if your group is feeling ambitious.

Active Options

- **Canoe Rental on Lake Louise** – Paddle across the turquoise waters with mountain reflections — super Instagram-worthy.
- **Horseback Riding** – Local outfitters offer trails from 1–3 hours through forest and meadows.
- **Guided Photography Hike** – Some companies lead short hikes focusing on fall colors, wildlife spotting, and capturing perfect shots.

Relaxation Options

- **Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise** – Afternoon tea on the terrace or lakeside dining.
- **Picnic by the Lake** – Grab snacks in town or from the hotel and enjoy a serene lakeside lunch.

Travel from Lake Louise to Jasper on a sightseeing tour through Banff and Jasper National Parks via the Icefields Parkway. Highlights include Bow Lake, the Columbia Icefield, Glacier Skywalk, and Athabasca Falls. Take a ride on an Ice Explorer onto the Athabasca Glacier and learn about its geology.



Ice Explorer

Tour the Athabasca Glacier in a giant six-wheel drive Ice Explorer vehicle while your guide explains the history of this ancient glacier and points out interesting geological features. Think of it like a "monster-truck meets glacier" adventure where you learn new things!

Glacier Skywalk

Consisting of a 400 metre (1,640 feet) interpretive boardwalk and a glass-floored observation platform extending 30 metres (98 feet) out over the Sunwapta Valley, Glacier Skywalk takes spectacular scenery and a rare view of nature to unbelievable heights. The award-winning architecture of the Skywalk is a feat of contemporary design.

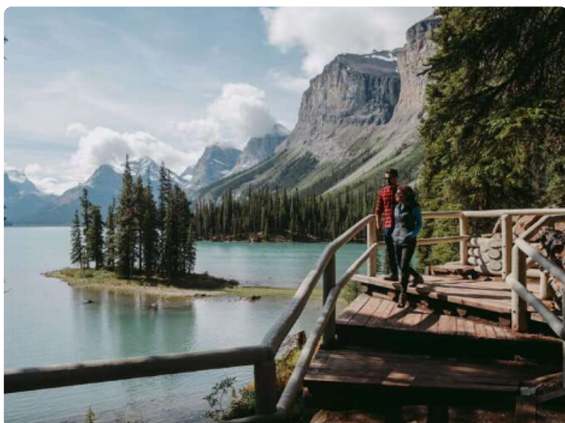
Jasper Skytram

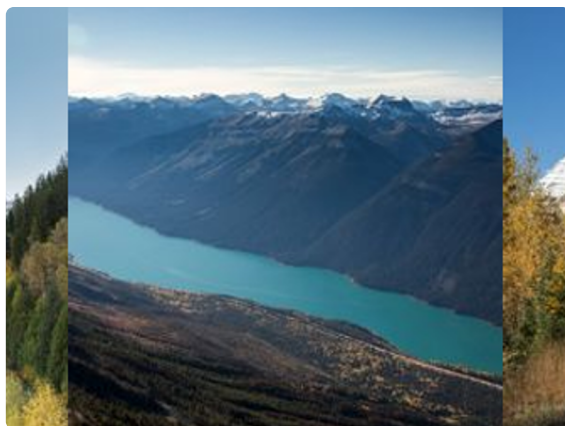
