## Overnight Flight → 1 night

### Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Dubrovnik today.

## Dubrovnik → 3 nights

### Day 2: Arrival in Dubrovnik

*Included meals: welcome dinner*

Welcome to Croatia! Gather with your fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

### Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Dubrovnik

*Included meals: breakfast*

Set on a peninsula on the Adriatic, Dubrovnik's massive walls have served as the city's calling card for centuries. Today, you'll take a guided tour.

- Pay a visit to the 13th-century Franciscan Monastery, which boasts the most extensive library in the region
- View the impressive Rector's Palace and the city's ornate cathedral

## Split Region → 2 nights

### Day 5: The Split Region via Mostar

*Included meals: breakfast*

Travel to the Split region today. Stop en route for a guided tour of Mostar, a city in southern Bosnia and Herzegovina.

- Enter an old Ottoman mosque and traditional Ottoman house
- Walk over the striking Old Bridge, a UNESCO World Heritage site that joins the banks of the Neretva River

### Day 6: Sightseeing tour of Split

*Included meals: breakfast, dinner*

Enjoy a guided tour of Split, a coastal city with a local culture that seamlessly combines tradition and modernity.

- Enter Diocletian's Palace, an enormous third-century palace complex
- View the monuments to the city's varied cultural influences, including Gothic churches, Renaissance palaces, Venetian fortifications, and an Egyptian sphinx
- Examine sculptures, drawings, and paintings at the Ivan Meštrović Gallery

## Plitvice → 2 nights

### Day 7: Plitvice via Trogir & Zadar

*Included meals: breakfast*

Transfer to Plitvice today. Along the way, you'll stop in two Dalmatian Coast towns for guided tours.

- Set off with your Tour Director and explore Trogir, where you'll wander past Radovan's Portal and Trogir Cathedral
- Join a local guide in the seaside town of Zadar to view Roman ruins and the one-of-a-kind Sea Organ

### Day 8: Sightseeing tour of Plitvice Lakes National Park

*Included meals: breakfast, dinner*

Embark on a guided tour of Plitvice Lakes National Park, 16 levels of lakes nestled between Mount Mala Kapela and Mount Pljesevica.

- Admire the upper lakes, forests, caves, and waterfalls with a local guide
- Visit the lower lakes with your Tour Director leading the way

## Zagreb → 1 night

### Day 9: Sightseeing tour of Zagreb

*Included meals: breakfast*

Continue on to Zagreb, where a local guide will introduce you to the best of Croatia's capital city on a walking tour.

- Pass by the Meštrović Pavilion, Zrinjevac Park, fortified Lotrščak Tower, and Mirogoj Cemetery

- Enter the Croatian Museum of Naive Art to admire the simplistic beauty of the artwork

## Ljubljana → 2 nights

### Day 10: Sightseeing tour of Ljubljana

*Included meals: breakfast*

Travel to Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia, and join a local expert for a guided tour.

- Stop in Prešeren Square to see the France Prešeren Monument
- Pass by the Triple Bridge, Town Hall, and Baroque Robba Fountain
- View Ljubljana Cathedral, the Dragon Bridge, and the famed open-air market

### Day 11: Free day in Ljubljana

*Included meals: breakfast, farewell dinner*

Enjoy a free day in Ljubljana or add an excursion. Tonight, celebrate your trip at a farewell dinner with your group.

- Enjoy free time for lunch in the small, lakeside village of Ribcev Laz

# Customize your experience

## Day 3: Scenic Dubrovnik Coast Cruise & Dinner

\$75/\$85\* (4 hours, departs in the evening, dinner included)

This excursion begins with a cruise along the shoreline of one of Europe's most romantic cities. Arriving on the beach, you'll dine at a local restaurant before setting out on a stroll through Dubrovnik's medieval streets. Please note: Travelers prone to seasickness should take the proper precautions.

during the First World War. Learn about the small town's history on a tour of the WWI trenches and landmarks before taking free time for lunch.

## Day 4: Montenegro

\$80/\$90\* (10 hours, departs in the morning, lunch included)

Set out to explore the small Republic of Montenegro, which is home to stunning backdrops that range from serene beaches to rugged mountain canyons. Begin in Perast, a Venetian town on the Bay of Kotor, where you'll take to the water to admire the surrounding scenery. Set sail and visit the famed islets of St. George and Our Lady of the Rocks. Then, enjoy lunch as you head to the UNESCO-protected town of Kotor, where you'll view medieval walls and churches nestled between the hills and the sea.

## Day 11: Postojna Cave & Predjama Castle

\$109/\$119\* (6.5 hours, departs in the morning)

Journey to two of Slovenia's most memorable sites. Your first stop is the legendary Postojna Caves, a 12.5-mile-long system of caverns. Later, you'll visit Predjama Castle, a Renaissance fort built into the mouth of a cave. A natural tunnel connects the castle to the top of the mountain; in the Middle Ages, this tunnel served as a secret supply line for the castle during times of siege. While you're here, you'll learn about the legend of Erazem Lueger, a robber baron who called this castle home.

## Extension excursion options

### Day 12: Piran: Slovenia's Adriatic Gem

\$99/\$109\* (7 hours, departs in the morning)

Famous for its Venetian architecture, Piran sits on the Mediterranean coast of Slovenia. Join a local guide and explore the town's narrow streets, passing by the medieval city walls as you go. Stop by the Church of St. George and Tartini Square, the beautiful main plaza dominated by a massive bronze statue of composer and violinist Giuseppe Tartini. Then, enjoy free time for lunch and take a dip in the Adriatic if the weather allows.

### Day 14: The Julian Alps: Triglav National Park

\$115/\$125\* (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Pass through lakeside scenery to the ski resort town of Kranjska Gora, close to the Italian and Austrian borders. Then, continue on to Triglav National Park. You'll drive through Vršič Pass, the highest pass in Slovenia and the Eastern Julian Alps. Stop along the way at the Soca River for a scenic walk full of photo opportunities of the surrounding Alpine landscape. Continue to Bovec, a small town in the Littoral region, which was devastated
