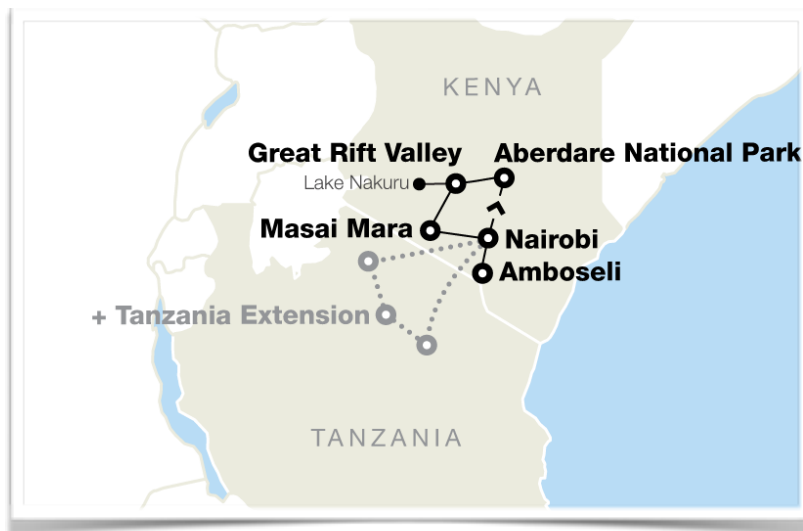

Quick Travel Tips

*Arrive at the airport 3 hours before scheduled take off time to ensure making the first flight.

*Stay hydrated leading up to and on the overseas flight. This will help combat both jet lag and Deep Vein Thrombosis.

*Purchase compression socks to wear on long flights which apply pressure to your lower legs, helping to maintain blood flow and reduce discomfort and swelling.



Trip Overview

13 days; 17 with Tanzania Extension

Tanzania Extension

The extension to Tanzania is 4 additional days. In addition to all we will see in Kenya, with the extension to Tanzania, we will also get to explore the following:

- A stop in Arusha on the way to Tarangire National Park... where we'll see one of Africa's largest herds of elephants, not to mention some of over 500 bird species.
- A stop in Olduvai Gorge for a guided tour before an afternoon game drive through Serengeti National Park.
- A day of game drives through the Central Serengeti's rich ecosystems and endless plains.
- A visit to the Ngorongoro Crater, and another afternoon game drive to look for lions, black rhinos, and cheetahs.



Passport & Visa Requirements

*In order to enter Kenya (and Tanzania on the tour extension), US citizens need a valid passport with an expiration date extending at least six months beyond the date of reentry.

*You need to have at least two blank passport pages for entry stamps.

*US passport holders must obtain a visa in advance in order to enter Kenya. While it is possible to obtain a visa at the airport, it's strongly recommended that you purchase the visa in advance. You can purchase an e-visa online through the Kenya Ministry of Foreign Affairs (<http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html>), or submit a request for a paper visa by visiting your local embassy. You can also purchase your visa by using a visa provider such as Go Ahead's partner VisaCentral: <https://visacentral.com/goaheadtours>. You will need to have your visa receipt with you upon arrival in Kenya.

*US passport holders must obtain a visa in order to enter Tanzania on the tour extension.

While it is possible to obtain a visa at the border, it's strongly recommended that you purchase your visa in advance as wait time

upon arrival can exceed 2 hours. You can purchase an electronic visa on the Tanzanian Electronic Visa Portal website: <https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa/>. You may also submit a request for a paper visa by visiting your local embassy or purchase your visa in advance by using a visa provider such as Go Ahead's partner VisaCentral: <https://visacentral.com/goaheadtours>. You will need to have your visa receipt with you upon arrival in Tanzania.

*If you are a Canadian citizen, the same rules apply. If you are not a US or Canadian citizen, you must contact each destination country's consulate for your specific entry requirements.

*Visas are good for 90 days, so don't purchase them too early.
